Director - Criminal Investigation Division (CID), Environmental Protection Agency



Jessica Taylor currently serves as the Director of the Criminal Investigation Division. She joined federal law enforcement in 1999 as a special agent with the United States Secret Service (USSS) in the Washington Field Office, where she investigated violations related to frauds committed against US financial systems (forgery, counterfeit currency, and identity theft) as well as threats against public officials. After 11 years with the Secret Service, Jessica joined the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Office of Inspector General (OIG) in April 2010 as the Assistant Special Agent-in-Charge of the Investigations, Liaison and Hotline Division (ILHD). Most recently Jessica served as the Special Agent-in-Charge of ILHD, where she was responsible for Congressional Hearing preparation and liaison work for 33 USDA agencies. She developed the Wildlife Trafficking Initiative and the Animal Fighting Initiative to diversify the investigative outreach of USDA OIG.
